Event Frequency: three-five events each spring and fall. one-two a month in summer.

Frequency of Assignment: one to two times a season

Access Considerations: This task requires long periods of sitting and/or standing, usually under a tent. The volunteer may be exposed to heat, sun, and humidity, but not typically bad weather. Must be able to clearly communicate and be comfortable with sometimes loud, busy, and spontaneous environments.

Orientation/Guide? Will be paired with a more experienced volunteer at first, and there are instructional pages with the tabling materials.
